Getting the Bigger Picture –
Performance workshop series

It is easy for us to get wound up by performance anxiety. It also confuses us: how is it you can play naturally at home, then find yourself overwhelmed at an exam, or on stage?

For a while now, the music conservatoires have had departments devoted to this enormous and powerful subject. It involves many aspects, in particular, psychology & physiology along with being you!

Join us to spend time taking a deeper look at issues of anxiety, at communication skills and the various things going on behind performance. Find out how to counter the effects nerves can have on your technique and your response to performing. This is a process and needs focus and a steady development. Prior to this class, you may want to start a journal particularly if you feel disturbed by any past experience you've had. Students can get past these – we have all found.

This day has helped many cellists get well prepared for exams, auditions & recitals.

Bring the piece you are intending to perform (even if it is a work in progress) and lets make changes in your perceptions and responses. The pianist is **Julian Broughton** – he's an exceptional accompanist and very calming!

June 1st – 3rd Extreme Cello Orchestra Weekend * New * Repertoire: Over the top, thrilling, chromatic & dramatic Verdi

This is a new and exciting course!

For those of you who can't make the longer course, this may fill that gap.

We meet & rehearse on Friday to kick off our exciting weekend. We can then go to a pub or cafe for supper, or, if commuting, there's time to catch the train home. On Saturday we combine rehearsal of the music with looking at the techniques & musical ideas we will focus on and develop.

On Sunday we will continue to rehearse and then perform for ourselves!

Heads up - Have a couple of weeks revisiting your chromatic scales! I hope that studying this piece and exploring it will help all of you playing 19th century orchestral repertoire, to feel more confident and informed.

October 20th Performance Series *Repertoire & style*

We will spend the day looking at some standard repertoire pieces from the Baroque, Classical, Romantic eras & some contemporary cello works that most of you will learn at some point. We will take a look at techniques and ideas alongside historical context to help you bring the music alive. I also have Baroque bows for you to borrow.

This era is where our string technique begins and knowing more will affect your bow use in later music, bringing a deeper understanding of articulation and sound production via your breathing, speaking bow.

Students leave the workshop with notes of the days work so you keep your development in motion.

At St Thomas's (Lewes) and St John's (Cambridge) Church halls, there is free parking on the door - step.

At All Saints parking is also close by at Pinwell Road and the Lewes Railway station car park.

The train station in Lewes is a 3 - minute walk from All Saints & about a 10 minute walk from St Thomas's.

In Cambridge, (if you are coming by train) you can catch a bus or taxi for the 5 - minute trip to Hills Road.

Cellos & bows:

I have some cellos & bows that can be rented for a nominal amount for those of you coming from abroad/ flying to make your journey stress-free. Just let me know in advance to earmark yours.

I also have Baroque bows for students to borrow and can help with buying an inexpensive one too.

On the day:

I provide music stands, pencils, cushions and coffees/teas and snacks.

On 1-day workshops you need to bring food (Cambridge workshops as there is nowhere close), or pop out to numerous places close by (in Lewes), to buy something at lunch - time. On the courses, delicious lunches set you up.
